- layout: UDC number; title in capital letters; under the title first and last names of the author (authors); then work place (or place of study) of the author (authors), main text, reference list;
- the text may contain standard abbreviations and comprise the following components: Introduction. Aim. Results. Discussion and conclusions. Keywords (3–5). References.
